

RON FAQs

Q: What is Remote Online Notary?

Q: Do you have to be in California to use RON?

A: No. While a Notary Public may only notarize documents in the state(s) in which they are licensed, the signer can get their document(s) notorized online from anywhere. This makes it an especially convenient service when you are working with out-ofstate/country buyers and sellers! Q: How do you set up a RON? A: Find a reputable notary service that offers RON and make an appointment. You will be asked to answer some questions about yourself, as well as provide proof of identification. Your notary will verify the validity of any identification documents you upload. Using video conferencing technology, your notary will walk you through the process. Once you are finished, you'll be able to download your notarized documents and submit them to the requesting parties. O: How safe is RON?
